N/B:

1. *Examinations for first semester end of 9th of April and not the 10th of April because of Good Friday.*
2. *The holidays between the first and second semester are shortened to two weeks so that the students can take a mid-semester break of 1 week for Eid-ul-fitr; this ensures that the length of the Semester is not affected by the celebration.*
3. *Eid-ul-Adha falls within the examination period for the second Semester; for this reason, examination dates are pulled back by two days to account for the possibility that a public holiday may be announced for the 9th or 10th of July. The examination timetable must take this into consideration.*
