ABOUT THE ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY OF KENYA

The Islamic University of Kenya has grown from a simple college established in 2002 into a fully chartered university known for academic excellence, strong values, and an expanding international presence. In 2024, the Islamic University of Kenya was granted its Charter, an achievement that affirmed its readiness to operate as a fully recognized university rooted in quality, ethics, and innovation.
