Aim of the Award

The principal aim of this scholarship program is to offer financial support and encourage serious and deserving students to continue their studies in the field of Business Management and Education. The focus of the award is aimed at the following programmes:

- Bachelor of Business Management
- Bachelor of Education – Arts
- Diploma in Business Management
- Post Graduate Diploma in Education

Scholarship Award

The award for the 2022 - 2023 academic year scholarship will be determined based on the Scholarship Committee's evaluation of the applications submitted and will cover tuition and accommodation fees ONLY over the duration of the studies of the following courses

School of Business and Economics

- Bachelor of Business Management
 - 5 scholarships covering 100% of tuition and accommodation fees
 - 10 Scholarships covering 75% of tuition and accommodation fees
 - 15 Scholarships covering 50% of tuition and accommodation fees
- Diploma in Business Management
 - 10 Scholarship covering 50% of tuition and accommodation fees

School of Education

- Bachelor of Education (Arts)
 - 5 scholarships covering 100% of tuition and accommodation fees
 - 10 Scholarships covering 75% of tuition and accommodation fees
 - 15 Scholarships covering 50% of tuition and accommodation fees
- Post Graduate Diploma in Education
 - 10 Scholarship covering 50% of tuition and accommodation fees

Eligibility of this Scholarship requires that applicants:

- Must be Committed Muslims of between 18-25 year of age
- Must demonstrate academic excellence having attained a minimum Entry requirement of specific programmes as indicated below
 - Bachelor of Business Management
 - KSCE Mean Grade of C+ and a C (plain) score in Mathematics
 - Bachelor of Education – Arts
 - KSCE Mean Grade of C+ and a C+ score in either of English, Arabic or/and Islamic Religious Studies
 - Diploma in Business Management
 - KSCE Mean Grade of C- (Minus)
 - Post Graduate Diploma in Education
 - Bachelor Degree of Arts/ Science
 - Mean grade C+ (plus) in KCSE or 1 principal and 2 subsidiaries.
 - Minimum C+ in the 2 teaching subjects
- Must demonstrate the need for education assistance
- Must demonstrate commitment to serve the community
- Must be willing to report for studies by **1st October 2022**

Scholarship application Requirements:

- Fully filled application forms
- Copy of Academic certificates including certificates from Islamic Religious institution
- Personal statement by the applicant demonstrating the need for assistance, academic qualification and career goals
- Letter from local masjid Imam or local leader in support of the applicants request for scholarship
- Demonstrate financial ability to cover the fees for the 75% and 50% scholarship award
- Demonstrate commitment to market the University to the community
